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ACTIVITIES REPORT

COMMERCE WORKSHOP (7TH NOVEMBER 2023)

On November 7, 2023, a commerce workshop was organized by the "Commerce Department" at the Dayawati Modi Academy in Modipuram. Various activities were carried out under the program. The program began with the school's prayer meeting. Subsequently, the headmaster of the school and the head of the Commerce Department, Mr. Rajiv Dhaka, presented a bouquet of flowers to the school's Principal, Dr. (Mrs.) Ritu Devan, and Deputy Principal Mr. Kapil Christopher.

Class 11 students Vriddhi Gupta and Ridhi Sharma, who were responsible for managing the stage, invited accountancy students to participate in a role-play. Through role-play, students explained that "Bank Solution Details" should be created every month so that there is no confusion and consumers can keep track of their passbooks and bank account transactions. Afterward, Class 11 students conducted various quizzes related to "Business Studies," such as insurance principles, logos marketing, and bank taglines. Along with this, a street play was performed to raise awareness about consumer protection and their rights.



Furthering the program, Class 11 students discussed supply, demand, consumer production, resources, and their scarcity with respect to economics through a song. A group discussion was also conducted comparing India and China's economic situations. Class 12 students Monal Singh, Yash, and Adishri gave a presentation on "Product Development Skills" using examples of jewelry and water bottles. They explained how a brand is created, promoted, marketed, transported, and how a unique selling proposition is formulated. They also conducted a quiz on "Company Logos" with everyone present. Banking-related questions were answered by Class 11 students through private and public bank tagline comparative analysis, followed by Q&A and PPT presentations on bank functions such as general functions, farmer schemes, new startup schemes, etc. Subsequently, students of Class 10 explained the subject of the stock exchange in India and New York through their beautiful presentation. They mentioned that NSE is the largest and most important stock exchange in India, demonstrating transparency in the Indian financial market. Many people living in India are unaware of this trading system. They also discussed NYSE, which is the world's largest stock exchange, and highlighted how many Indian companies are registered on it and the benefits associated with it. The objective of this program was to foster creativity and develop comparative analysis skills among students.
